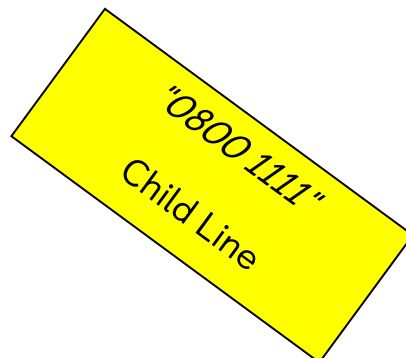
Have a wonderful half term and we will see you on Tuesday 5th June.
