- talk about how important school is and encourage my child to do the best they can
- support the school's policies and guidelines for learning and behaviour. Talk to my child about how important good behaviour is so that they can focus on learning
- encourage my child to work hard—to do well you have to work hard and practise learning
- make sure my child comes to school each day and that they know how important good attendance is
- make sure my child comes to school on time
- let the school know when and why my child isn't in school on the morning of any absence
- help my child with any home work or take home tasks. Ensure that they have a quiet place to learn and do their homework in good time
- ensure that my child reads at home at least 3 times every week, daily is best; sometimes with an adult sometimes practising by themselves
- come to all Parents Evenings and take part in discussions about my child's progress
- take an interest in what is happening at school
- talk to the school about any concerns that I have
