You are expected to complete at least one task each week.

You should attempt at least one 'EXTRA HOT' task!



### Writing

Imagine you are a princess and have been captured by a dragon. Write your story OR  
Imagine you are a knight who has to save someone from a dragon- write a story about your adventures.

### Research

Pick a castle of your choice to research. Present your findings in any way you wish (booklet and poster).

### DT

Design and create a castle using materials of your choice. Think about the different features of a castle.

### Reading

Write a book review on your favourite M.P Robertson book that we have read in class.

### Writing

Can you make a glossary using dragon and castle words? For example.... Turret – a small tower found on a castle

### Art

Can you design a feast for a King or Queen, think about what foods they will eat and what food were around hundreds of years ago.

### Maths

Draw a picture of a castle using only 2D shapes. Use as many as possible and try to use lots of different shapes. You can colour your picture.

### Maths

King Henry VIII sees an enemy army approaching his castle. There are horses and men. He can see 50 legs. How many horses and how many men- find all the possible answers. What if he could see 100 legs?

### Writing/maths

Write a riddle about a shape. E.g I have 3 sides, 3 corners and all my sides are straight.

### Art and Design

Design your own dragon, what is he going to look like? What colours are you going to use?

### Art

Create a royal portrait of yourself. Think about what you are going to wear.

### Handwriting

Practise your handwriting, think about the formation of your letters.
