You are expected to complete at least one task each week.

You should attempt at least one 'EXTRA HOT' task!



Writing and Drama

Write a play script about a voyage of discovery, maybe pirates or explorers sent by the queen.

(Props and costumes welcome!)

Design and Make

Learn about the design of cannons. Create a model of your own cannon and a booklet explaining how they worked.

History

The lens was a Tudor invention that, when added to the camera obscura, led to modern photography and film. Create a timeline of the main events in the history of photography, from Tudor times to today.

Poetry

Explorers were at sea for years at a time, create a poem, song or rap about life at sea. Remember to find out about daily jobs, food and weather.

ICT

Choose an aspect of the Tudor topic you have enjoyed most or would like to find out more about. Create a Power Point presentation (or any other slide app) of your research using pictures, web-links and sound effects. Present to the class at the end of term.

Persuasive Writing

Create a holiday brochure for the Tudor times, persuade people to want to travel by ship and discover new lands.

Research and do

Learn 3 knots, such as a reef knot, that Tudor sailors may have needed on their voyages. Teach them to someone else in the class.

Maths

Kings and queens use Roman numerals so we do not get confused if they have the same names. Please create some difficult Maths questions for your teacher that use Roman numerals!

Author Study

Research an author and read 3 books by them. Write a review about them and find 3 elements that link the books. This could be writing style, themes or illustrators.

Research and Writing

Research a famous Tudor explorer from Elizabeth I reign. Write a biography of their life and discoveries.

Art

Make a collage of a scene of a ship at sea, think of the different shades of colour, shape of the waves and how light might reflect off the water.

Art and Design

Imagine you could send postcards during Tudor times. Design, make and write a postcard from a sailor who has just reached a new land.
