How it teaches 'Community'

How it teaches 'Identity'

- Different cultures and their games.
- How can I respect others?

How it teaches 'Connections'

- How can I encourage others in my family, school and community?
- How do I treat others when I am happy or when I am sad?

Project Finale

Plan and make a marble game.

Games open morning with parents to share marble game and teach them how to play. Share other games together.

- Time adverbials
