

## Drama / musicality

### Topic Overview

The aim of the topic is for the children to explore Shakespeare as a story teller. We will delve into the famous Shakespeare plays - including Macbeth and Midsummer Night Dream.

Our topic will end with a trip to Chichester Theatre to experience storytelling coming alive.

### How it teaches 'Community'

- Pupils will learn how everybody contributes to a diverse community and brings these skills together for stage productions.

### How it teaches 'Identity'

- Pupils will explore what they like, and ask which plays appeal to which audience.

### How it teaches 'Connections'

- Pupils will make connections with famous storytellers through time.

### Project Finale

The learning outcome will be a visit to Chichester Theatre to experience storytelling coming alive on the stage.

- Costing and sourcing snacks for the theatre trip
