Topic Overview

Looking at games with a focus on turn taking and instructions.

How can we use games in other subjects?

Respecting others both in and outside of school.

How it teaches 'Community'

- Respecting the wishes and opinions of others through game sharing.
- Building special relationships with other pupils.

How it teaches 'Identity'

- What games do I like to play? What do I enjoy about them?
- Sharing experiences of playing games at home.

How it teaches 'Connections'

- Is there anybody with the same likes/ dislikes as me?
- Can I use my turn taking skills at other times?

Project Finale

The children will each produce a picture to be made into a pair of snap cards- class set to be produced.

The parents will be invited in to share the class snap pack, alongside other games, with their child.

Literacy links

- Developing sound recognition, segmenting and blending.
- Retelling stories with actions
- Speaking in full sentences.

Numeracy links

- Numerals 1-10.
- Days of the week/months of the year.
- Adding and subtracting numbers within 10.

- Art -Creating a topic related picture to be made into a snap card.
- The world- what games do they play in other countries?
