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
Year 1 - Term 5 - Home-learning Medley

Try and use all the super skills we have taught you to use in your writing!</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>How many countries does the United Kingdom have? Can you write a fact file about the different countries? What are they like? Draw pictures too if you like ☺</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Recognise and draw all of the coins we have in our coin system.
