

## How well do you know me?

### Topic Overview

The aim of the topic is for the children to consider their 'identity' – Who am I? What do I like? What do I dislike? What makes me, me?

We will think about these types of questions and discuss them, whilst also reflecting on how we are all different, and that it is okay to be different.

As part of this journey we will identify who and how we are connected to others by our own identity.

### How it teaches 'Community'

- We will consider their role in the community
- What other identities are in the local community

### How it teaches 'Identity'

- Who am I? What are my dislikes? What are my likes?
- Why is it good to be me?

### How it teaches 'Connections'

- Based on my likes and dislikes, how am I connected to others.
- Who shares similar interests?

### Project Finale

The learning outcome will be a parent and child 'Mr & Mrs' style gameshow.

The event will be held like a real life gameshow where contestants have to try and match up answers about each other to see who knows each other the best!
