### Topic Overview

During this unit of work, children will explore The Lion King in connection with different communities. From this, we will explore our own community and the leadership roles within it. We will be thinking about why we need a leader and what makes a good leader within a school.

### How it teaches 'Community'

- We will be looking at traditional African tribes and the dynamics within their communities.
- We will be mostly focusing on leadership.

### How it teaches 'Identity'

- We will be exploring different identities and responsibilities within a community.
- We will be thinking about the different leadership roles within our own community and how we can be good leaders.

### How it teaches 'Connections'

- We will be linking our learning to the leadership and communities within The Mill.
- We will be writing job descriptions for leadership within our school

### Project Finale

We will be producing job descriptions for leadership roles within our school.
