

Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

The Government has taken the decision to close schools at the end of school day on Friday 20th March until further notice.

We are awaiting further news from the government about keeping school open for the children of key workers such as NHS and care workers, firefighters, police or supermarket delivery drivers. In order for your child to attend as of Monday, <u>parents or carers need to be keyworkers</u>. Your job will need to be on the official list of key workers which, as this goes 'to print' has not been officially confirmed. We will ask parents or carers who are key workers to have some ID to confirm their role such as ID cards or payslips.
