A plea to key worker parents

Out of fairness to all of our families and our staff, and to help reduce the spread of Covid in the community, please only take up a school place in the next two days if you truly cannot manage childcare within your own home. Going forward, if restrictions should continue, we will be asking all parents who have requested a place for proof of work as a key worker and following all guidelines strictly. I would sooner inform you of this now so as to avoid disappointing those who may not qualify.

<u>Gates</u>

Please use your usual gates when dropping your children into school and collecting them. Please remember the gates open from 8.30am and the collection time is now 2.50pm for Early Years and 3.00pm for all other year groups, including the siblings of Early Years children. All the collection points remain the same. The children will be taught in year groups by their familiar adults as we have managed to ensure staff are teaching in their usual year group bubbles.

If your child is coming into school for the next two days, please send them with a packed lunch. For those children who are entitled to FSM Vouchers, we will advise when we have an update on issuing these.
