#### Science Week

What an exciting Science Week we had at The Mill! Thank you to all families who dressed up their children as scientists today, The Mill looks and feels amazing today with all the fabulous costumes you came up



with! Have a look at all the great things our year groups have been up to this week!

EYFS This week Reception have been learning about engineers and their different roles. We have been learning this through a story called 'Porty's Whizzing Recovery' and completing different challenges using Lego and completing our 'Engineering Notebook'!

Year 1 This week Year 1 have been learning about the different features of brilliant bridges. The children worked in groups to design and build a bridge strong enough to hold a heavy object using only paper, straws and tape.

Year 2 This week Year 2 have been learning about motion and the use of jigs. We built our very own cardboard cars in groups using some parts as jigs in order to mark out the holes.

Year 3 This week Year 3 have been learning about engineering. We studied super structures and learned how to make structures strong. We then tested how strong our structures were using weights.

Year 4 This week Year 4 have been learning to be structural engineers. We worked with partners to investigate which shape is the strongest when building structures.

Year 5 This week Year 5 have been learning about engineering, we started with a video Q&A session with the head of engineering at Gatwick. For the rest of the week we built our own motorised cars in groups.


