Important – Ordering Lunches

Before the half term, we informed you about the changes in the lunch provision at The Mill which gives us the fantastic opportunity to have hot school meals cooked on site and provide a tasty and nutritious lunch for your children. Each day Caterlink will provide a choice of a meat or vegetarian option and a jacket potato option. These are the key changes:

- All meals will need to be booked via the SchoolMoney App
- All meals including children who are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 or those who are entitled to Free School Meals will need to be pre-booked via the SchoolMoney App
- If your child is in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 or Year 6 and you are NOT entitled to Free School Meals, you can book meals at the cost of £2.45 per day
