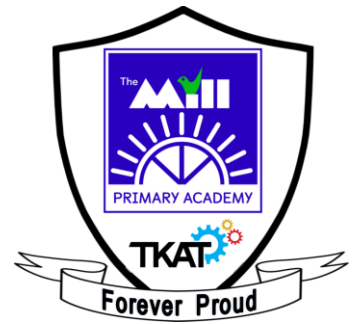


The Mill Primary Academy PE kit policy

At The Mill, we recognise P.E as a key area of learning in our school. All of our children take part in PE lessons weekly, as well as having many opportunities to take part in extra curricular clubs and represent The Mill in competitions against other schools. Having the correct kit is crucial to ensure our children can be as active as possible.

To maximise PE lesson time, on their PE days children can wear their full PE kit to school and are not required to wear their uniform. If your child has a club after school, they are required to wear their full school uniform and bring in something appropriate for their club to change into after school. **This must be a full school PE kit as stated below.** If your child forgets to wear their kit, they will still take part in the lesson (where it is safe to do so) and you will receive a reminder letter, followed up by the class teacher.

PE kit

- Plain white t-shirt
- Plain navy/black shorts
- Plimsolls or trainers
- No jewellery and all hair must be tied back

During colder months, children are also encouraged to bring in a plain hoodie and tracksuit bottoms to keep warm.

Unable to take part

If your child cannot take part in PE for any reason, please provide a letter to your child's teacher explaining the reasons for this. Unless your child has a serious injury/illness, they will be expected to take part. Children unable to take part in PE are required to come into school in full school uniform.
